2. Validates Jesus as the Son of God (Mk.8:31, 9:31, 10:33 – 34)

1. Transformation (Jn.11:25 – 26; 1 Cor.15:50 – 58; 1 Jn.3:2; Luk.24:36 – 43)
2. The power of the believers (Acts 3:6 – 16, 4:18 – 20, 9:40 – 43, 20:9 – 12; Eph.2:6 – 7)
3. The Rapture (1 The 4:13 – 18; Rev.1:18)

1. The unique resurrection of Jesus (Rom.6:9) is more than the miracles of raising the dead (Jn.11:38 – 44; Mk.5:35 – 42)
2. It is pivotal to our Christian faith (1 Cor.15:12 – 19)

B. Proof of the Resurrection

1. The empty tomb (Mat.28:1, 5 – 6; Jn.20:1 – 3; Luk.24:5 – 7)
2. The witnesses (Mat.28:8 – 10; Luk.24:36b – 43; Jn.20:12 – 29; 1 Cor.15:3 – 9)
3. Post resurrection changes (Acts 2:14 – end; 4:19 – 20)
