Prayer Summary on 4.9.2019

Topic: Pray for the Pulpit Ministry

1. IMPORTANCE OF PREACHING AND TEACHING GOD'S WORD

Preaching is one of the gifts given by the Holy Spirit in Eph 4:11-13 to build up God's church until we are all mature and complete. The Methodists were the first to set up circuit preaching by lay people in the 18th Century so their congregations were served hearty meals from God's Word. Therefore the Bible needs to be taught and proclaimed constantly as often as possible.

2. PRAY FOR THE PREACHERS AND TEACHERS

A. They will be God's mouthpiece when they preach the Word of God, be able to both convict those people who need correction and also encourage those people who are down and broken and to meet the needs of every single member of the congregation.

B. They will walk the talk and their lives will model and be an example to those people they are proclaiming to; closeness to their congregations so they will know whom they are preaching to especially their needs and closeness to God so that they will be able to know God's heart beat and always deliver a word in season

C. Improve themselves through growing as a Christian, studying so they can preach better sermons that will touch and minister to the congregation.

3. PRAY FOR THE CONGREGATION

A. That they will be thirsty and hungry for God's Word, apply it to their lives so they will be changed constantly to be like Jesus.

B. Be inspired to read and study the Bible daily and be able to share of how their lives have been changed as a witness to others and edify their fellow Christians
